

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON REALIGNING REGENT DISTRICTS

According to the 2010 Census data, the District's regent districts are not of sufficiently equal population and must be redrawn in order to comply with the "one-person, one-vote" principle established by the U.S. Constitution.

The Board of Regents of the Del Mar College District is considering new boundaries for its regent districts and wants to hear from you. Tell us what you think about the preliminary regent district plan at the public hearing described below:

Room 131; Corpus Christi TX Monday through Friday from now until the date of the public hearing.

A copy of the plan is also available at www.delmar.edu. In addition you need to be aware that the District has adopted Guidelines for public participation. The Guidelines, among other things, require that comments be submitted in writing even if you make them orally at the hearing; all written comments are due by the close of the hearing.
