Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. [Are the new application acceptance dates temporary?](#)

No, the changes to the application acceptance cycles and deadline dates are permanent unless NursingCAS.org requires nursing programs to make additional changes in the future.

2. [I'm taking BIOL 2402 in the Summer II Session. Can I still apply for Spring Admission?](#)

Yes, you may still submit an application by July 31st and be conditionally accepted for Spring Admission to the nursing program. However, the course will not count toward your Program GPA or ranking points for class selection. In addition, you must make a grade of C or better in the course and have an overall Program GPA of 2.5 or higher before you are officially accepted into the program.

3. [What happens if one of my official transcripts is delivered to NursingCAS after August 19th?](#)

Your application will not be processed by NursingCAS and you will not be considered for admission to the nursing program. Submit requests for official transcripts to all colleges/universities you have attended as soon as possible to ensure they arrive at NursingCAS before the August 19th deadline.

All students, including Del Mar College students, should use the "Download Transcript Request Form" feature in the "Academic History" section of the NursingCAS online application to obtain the form needed by the Registrar's office to process your request.

4. [If I am not accepted to the nursing program, can I reapply?](#)

Yes, you may reapply for admission through NursingCAS.org using the "Re-Applicant" feature to carry over existing data from the previous application cycle. Carry over data includes personal information, academic history, coursework data, and official transcripts.

5. [Are the application fees changing for the new application cycles?](#)

No. Applicants will still pay a \$45 application fee to NursingCAS per academic year when submitting applications to the Del Mar Nursing Program.

Applicants who have previously applied during a Fall admission application cycle (Nov 1st to Jan 31st) and were not accepted may reapply to the nursing program during the following Spring admission application cycle (May 1st to July 31st) without having to pay an additional fee. Applicants for Spring Admission who are not accepted and want to

reapply will be required to pay another \$45 application fee to NursingCAS for the next academic year.
