

## NursingCAS Applicants

### Application Tips

- > **Check Your Status Online** - You can check on the status of your application online by clicking on the options under the "Quick Status" menu when logged into your [application homepage](#).
- > **Begin the Application Process Early** - If you wait until the night before a program deadline to submit your application, your application may not be received by NursingCAS in time. You should apply at least four weeks before the earliest deadline of the program(s) that you are applying to. This will allow the necessary time to verify and process your application.
- > **Enter All Colleges Attended** - Enter all undergraduate, graduate, professional and foreign institutions that you have attended even if it was only for a single course or college credit awarded while you were in high school. Official transcripts will be necessary for all undergraduate, graduate and professional coursework (taken toward a bachelor's degree). Foreign coursework (non-Canadian) will need to be evaluated for U.S. equivalency.
- > **Enter All College Level Course Work** - You must enter all coursework including courses in which you received a grade of "W" or "Inc." Enter all in-progress and planned coursework. This will help programs decide if you are planning to take required courses in the future.
- > **Review the [Applicant Checklist](#).**
- > **Remember to give the registrar the [Transcript Request Form](#)** to mail along with your official transcript in order to expedite the processing of your application. You can access the Transcript Request Form [here](#) once you enter in your colleges attended in this section of the application. Note that you will have a different Transcript Request Form for each college attended.
